Day 1:

- 10:00AM Arrive at **Country Ovens, Forestville**. Stop in and shop the country store, home of the Cherry-Delite. Established in 1987, specializing in dried fruits and preserves. .
- 12:00PM Make your way north on Hwy 42 to enjoy lunch at **Bistro 42** located inside **Door Peninsula Winery & Door County Distillery, Carlsville**. Known for its stone hearth oven, fire baked pizzas and exceptional wines. After lunch peruse the showroom, take a winery or distillery tour and indulge in a wine tasting with over 50 different varieties of wine to choose from.
- 1:30PM For desert make a stop at **Schopf’s Hilltop Dairy, Carlsville**. A family fun stop that’s educational and entertaining. Learn about the Wisconsin dairy industry and experience it first hand by watching the ongoing milk operations, milk cookie the cow and then taste the end result. Enjoy over 30 flavors of homemade ice cream.
- 3:00PM See how things were done over 100 years ago at the **Anderson Store, Ephraim**. The store was established in 1858 and operated by the Anderson Family for over 100 years. It is now open as both a museum and a store.
- 4:00PM Check into hotel for some **R&R**.
- 6:15PM Experience a Fish Boil at **The White Gull Inn, Fish Creek** located on the west end of Fish Creek at 4225 Main Street. A historic Inn and restaurant established in 1896, located in the bayside village. It features whitefish caught by local fishermen and cooked outside over an open fire, just as it was one hundred years ago by Scandinavian settlers of the Peninsula. Seconds are always welcome but make sure you leave room for a piece of traditional Door County Cherry Pie.
- 7:30PM Walk down to **Sunset Park, Fish Creek** and see the most amazing sunset you’ll ever experience.

Day 2:

- 8:30AM **Breakfast at Al Johnson's, Sister Bay.** Enjoy their famous Swedish pancakes with lingonberries and don't miss the live goats grazing on the restaurants roof.
- 9:30AM Jump into the past and visit the **Anderson House, Sister Bay.** Take the tour of the farm house built in 1875, the restored farm buildings, log cabins, sawmill and turn of the century furnishings, farm implements, tools and historic photos.
- 11:30AM For lunch visit **Wilson's Ice Cream Parlor,** located in the heart of Ephraim since 1906. A classic Door County landmark that takes even the youngest visitors back in time with its old-fashioned soda fountain and ice cream specialties, home-brewed draft root beer, flame broiled burgers and juke boxes that play all the classics.
- 12:45PM **Orchard Country Winery & Market, Fish Creek.** Discover the orchards and vineyards, on site tours, fruit picking, wine tasting and picnic area.
- 2:00PM Stop at **Greens & Grains, Egg Harbor** and experience Door County's first and only full service natural food store. They carry a full line of natural groceries including local, organic produce, poultry and meat, supplements, personal care items and educational materials.
- 2:30PM Enjoy an afternoon of **R&R or shopping.**
- 6:00PM Attend a **Cooking School.** Door County offers one of a kind cooking schools in Ellison Bay and Sister Bay. Learn about locally grown ingredients while improving your culinary skills.

Day 3:

- 8:00AM Discover delicious food, warm hospitality and friendly service at **The Inn at Cedar Crossing, Sturgeon Bay.** Traditional and specialty breakfasts, pastries and fresh ground coffee start everyday.
- 9:00AM On your way out of town make one last stop at **Renard's Cheese** in Southern Door and stock up before returning home.
