### Four day – Three night tour

#### **Day One:**

- 2:00PM Begin your trip to Door County with a stop at the Door County Visitor Bureau for your own personal **Meet & Greet**. POC: Michelle Rasmusson 920-243-1127
- 2:15PM Continue your tour at the **Door County Maritime Museum**, Sturgeon Bay. They offer docent guided tours of the maritime related exhibits that span the nautical history of Door County from early American Indian canoes to post World War II bulk carriers.

- 4:00PM **Check into hotel for a little R&R.**
- 5:30 PM Enjoy a traditional **Fish Boil Dinner**. Local fish boils feature whitefish caught by local fishermen and cooked outside over an open fire, just as it was one hundred years ago by Scandinavian settlers of the Peninsula. - 7:30PM **Peninsula Players Theatre in a Garden-** Arrive an hour before the show at Peninsula Players to view the sun setting over the waters of Green Bay, stroll the cedar lined shore and enjoy the colorful gardens. Play schedule to be published early March.

- 8:15AM Door County **Circle Tour** aboard the Door County Trolley or with Step On Guide
- 11:00AM Board **Washington Island Ferry** for half-hour trip through Death’s Door en route to Washington Island
- 11:30AM Visit the **Washington Island Art and Nature Center** located in an old Schoolhouse, the art gallery features works of local artists including watercolors, prints, jewelry and photography. The nature room has many displays including an observation beehive and a 180 gallon fresh water fish exhibit. A naturalist is available to answer questions and lead hikes. - 4:00PM Return to **hotel** for **R & R** – or walking trip to local shopping & galleries
- 5:30PM **Dinner** at one of Door County's finest restaurants.
- 7:00PM Enjoy **American Folklore Theatre**. Experience a night of musical fun in a town hall setting – always original, truly professional, memorably musical.
