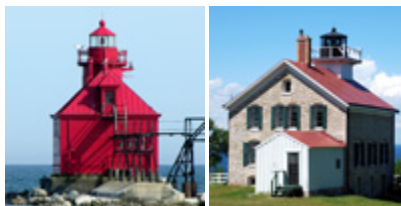
Sunday, Day One:



*1:30 p.m. Fly into Milwaukee – Meet & Greet*

*4:30 p.m. Welcome to Door County featuring 11 lighthouses from Sturgeon Bay to Washington Island. – Check into hotel.*



*6:15 p.m. A traditional Fish Boil awaits you for dinner at one of the many restaurants featuring this Door County specialty. Top off the meal with Door County cherry pie.*



*9:00 p.m. Return to hotel – sleep tight!*

*7:30 a.m. Breakfast at one of Door County's great early morning spots.*



8:30 a.m.

*Depart for Washington Island Ferry.*

9:30 a.m.

*Board the Washington Island Ferry for a half-hour scenic trip through Death's Door en route to Washington Island.*

10:30 a.m.

*Arrive on Washington Island and board the Cherry Train. Share the history, folklore and legends of island life with your expert tour guide. [www.cherrytrain.com](http://www.cherrytrain.com)*

Lunch

1:00p.m.

*Learn some more about the Door County's rich maritime history at the Jackson Harbor Maritime Museum, located in two former fishing sheds, where fisherman continue in the commercial fishing trade. View artifacts, photographs and videos on local maritime history including commercial fishing, Coast Guard and area shipwrecks.*



*2:00 p.m. Board the Washington Island Ferry and return to the Peninsula.*

*3:00 p.m. Go back to the hotel for some R&R before dinner.*

*5:30 p.m. Board the Harbor Lady for a cocktail cruise. Enjoy the view of Sturgeon Bay Canal & North Pierhead Light.*



*7:00 p.m. Depart for Peninsula Players where the sun sets, the curtain rises and the stars shine. Peninsula Players is celebrating 75 years of distinguished artistic excellence along the shore of Green Bay.*

*9:30 p.m. Return to hotel*

**Tuesday, Day Three:**

*7:30 a.m. Meet in hotel lobby for check-out.*

*8:15 a.m. Breakfast at Al Johnson's – see the famous goats on the roof and enjoy the marvelous lingonberries atop a stack of pancakes. Leave time for shopping in the fabulous gift store.*



*10:00 a.m. Tour the quiet side of Door County along Lake Michigan. Stop for a tour Cana Island Lighthouse, maintained by the Door County Maritime Museum. Take a walk across the rock causeway to tour the lighthouse. Take in the rugged beauty of one of the Great Lakes*

*most photographed lighthouses. Tour the keeper's house, climb the tower, and browse through the gift shop.*



**11:30 a.m.**

*Arrive at the Door County Maritime Museum, Sturgeon Bay, offering docent guided tours of the maritime related exhibits that span the nautical history of Door County from early American Indian canoes to post World War II bulk carriers. The current exhibit features haunted lighthouses entitled "GHOSTS." Take a tour of the tug boat.*



**1:00 p.m.**

*Depart for Manitowoc - Take the scenic drive down Hwy. 42 to see the Kewaunee Pierhead and Algoma Pierhead. Stop for lunch. Enjoy the view from TwoRivers Point Beach of the Rawley Point Lighthouse operated by the U/S. Coast Guard since 1853.*

**3:00 p.m.**

*Arrive Manitowoc – tour the Fish Shantie. Make a brief stop at the Wisconsin Maritime Museum.*

**5:00 p.m.**

*Depart Manitowoc*

**6:30 p.m.**

*Check in to hotel in Milwaukee.*

**7:30 p.m.**

*Dine on the lakefront at the newly renovated Pieces of Eight (renamed) – now operated by Bartolotta's and the only restaurant on the Milwaukee lakefront.*

9:30 p.m.                      *Return to hotel.*

Wednesday – Day Four:

9:00 a.m.                      *Step-on guide tour of Milwaukee to include the overlook of Lake Michigan to the Milwaukee Pierhead & Breakwater Light and Northpoint*

11:00 a.m.                      *Depart for Racine*

11:45 a.m.                      *Lunch at Spinnakers*

1:00 p.m.                      *Step on Guided Tour of Racine with a stop at the Windpoint Lighthouse, which is the oldest and tallest working lighthouse on Lake Michigan.*

3:00 p.m.                      *Return to Milwaukee for R & R at hotel*

6:30 p.m.                      *Dine at Wisconsin's most popular attraction – Potawatomi Bingo Casino.*

9:00 p.m.                      *Return to hotel*
