The Ephraim Historical Foundation was formed in 1949 to preserve and share the history of this Door County community.

We are funded entirely through tour revenue and donations.

Tour Length and Details: 90 minutes is the preferred bus tour length. This allows for visits to three EHF museums (Anderson Store, Pioneer Schoolhouse, Goodletson Cabin) and a guided tour through Ephraim.

Dates: Bus tours are offered June-October.

Group Size: We can accommodate groups of up to 55 people.

Cost: Our discounted bus tour price is \$3 per person. Driver and tour planner receive complimentary admission.

Location: Tours begin at the Anderson Barn Museum at 3060 Anderson Lane in Ephraim. Tour buses can park along the north side of Anderson Lane for easy drop-off and pick-up.

Accessibility: EHF tours require a minimal amount of walking. However, several of our historic buildings are located on a hill and have stairs. If your group has physical limitations, please contact us.
