## Door County Cherries

You can typically expect to see cherry blossoms during the middle to the end of May. The crop usually ripens mid-July through the end of July. These are both weather-driven events and will vary each year.

Door County is the 4th largest cherry producing region in the nation. The top three producing regions are Michigan, New York, and Utah.

All but 100 acres of Wisconsin's red cherry crop is grown in Door County.

Door County has approx. 2000 acres of Montmorency (tart) cherry orchards. The sweet cherry crop consists of only 50 acres, just enough to supply local roadside markets.

Cherries have been grown in Door County since the late 1800's. The moderating effects of the surrounding waters make the county's climate ideal for cherries.
